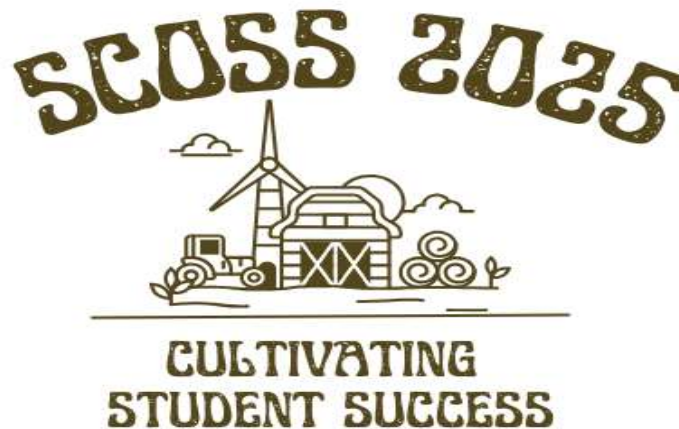


# **CALL FOR PROPOSALS**

# Conference Proposal Guidelines

The SCOSS Conference Committee welcomes any proposals on topics related to education: including, but not limited to: advising, personal health, the joys of teaching, and the conference theme: SCOSS 2025 Spring Conference Cultivating Student Success. Proposals should be based on sound theoretical practices, research, and ongoing practices in the field of education.

Appropriate topics are not limited to but can include:

- † Emotional intelligence
- † Self-efficacy
- † Self-awareness, stress management, and/or conflict resolution strategies
- † Classroom management & instructional delivery techniques
- † Student personal responsibility (study skills, time management)
- † Teaching and learning techniques for learning-challenged students
- † Supportive systems such as tutoring and supplemental instruction
- † Methods to facilitate student success
- † Advising and recruitment

## Session Format

Forty-five (45) minutes is allotted for each presentation, including question and answer time. Sessions may include lectures/discussions, hands-on activities, panel presentations, or demonstrations.

Presentations will be offered as concurrent sessions on Friday, April 4, 2025.

All presentation rooms are equipped with a computer, projector, screen, hand-held microphone, lapel microphone, and podium. However, Presenters may bring their laptop computer and attachments.

QR codes will link to session evaluations following each session.

**NOTE:** SCOSS is unable to reimburse presenters for travel or hotel expenses. Presenters must register and pay conference fees, which include lunch and beverage breaks.

**DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION:** February 28, 2025. Proposal acceptance emails will be sent no later than March 14, 2025.

# Procedures for Submitting a Proposal

1. Complete the proposal form and submit the following Word documents or follow the link provided.

**Abstract:** In approximately 200 words, describe your session. Include (a) objectives, (b) content of your presentation, (c) application to the conference theme, and (d) summary of major points. Please type on a separate page.

**Summary:** Type a summary (maximum 50 words) on a separate page with the title of the presentation and the name(s) of the presenters. If your proposal is accepted, this summary will appear in the program.

The deadline for submission of proposals is **February 28, 2025**.

A committee will review all proposals and contact you by **March 14, 2025**.
